Resources for finding a Psychiatrist in and around Burlington, Vermont:

- **Primary Care Providers (PCP)** Ask your doctor if there is a psychiatrist they know or who is affiliated with their practice who they can refer you to.
- Community Health Centers of Burlington (CHCB) 802-864-6309 If you don't have a PCP, consider establishing care at CHCB. CHCB providers include primary care and mental health clinicians, including psychiatrists. Website: https://www.chcb.org/
- Otter Creek Associates 802-865-3450 Otter Creek is an affiliation of psychiatrists, psychologists, and psychotherapists. There is an Intake Coordinator on staff who can help you find an affiliated psychiatrist, if one is available.
- UVM Medical Center Outpatient Adult Psychiatry (UVMMC): 802-847-4560 UVMMC has an Intake Coordinator who might be able to help you schedule an appointment with a psychiatrist. There is often a long wait for appointments and you might need a referral from your PCP in order to get an appointment.
- Vermont Center for Children, Youth and Families (at UVMMC) 802-847-4563 High quality mental health services for children and adolescents. To make an appointment, a referral from your PCP or pediatrician is required. Psychiatrists on staff. There is often a long wait list for appointments.
